Goal

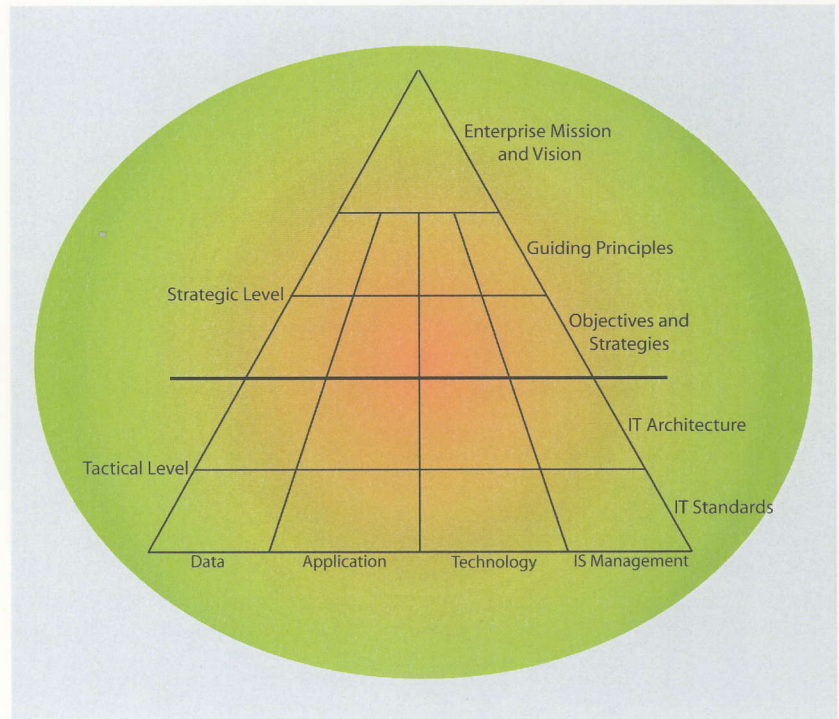
